PRINCESS ROYAL SAILING CLUB INC

Princess Royal Sailing Club is located on the water's edge of Princess Royal Harbour in Little Grove. The Club house stands high looking over the beautiful harbor to the city of Albany, providing a magnificent view both day and night.


Our club was formed in 1909 by Frank Dymes and during 2009 we celebrated our Centenary. Another highlight of the 2009 activities was the reinstatement of WA's most prestigious and challenging Ocean Races, the Fremantle to Albany Yacht Race. The first Fremantle to Albany Race was conducted in 1968 and during the 1970's & 1980's became the States' premier Ocean Race. The last race was held in 1997 so it was a welcome return after an absence of 12 years.

The Club's first meeting held at the Royal George Hotel on Stirling Terrace. Club races were conducted in those days from the Town Jetty. During the 1950's the Shire of Albany granted the Sailing Club a lease of land at Pagoda Point in Little Grove, where we are now located.

Over the last 68 years the Clubrooms and Marina has grown to what we see today. The Princess Royal Sailing Club forms part of the proud maritime history in the city of Albany.




Course Layout Start Boat Diagram





Boat Rigging Area
